Activities

- Nursing Staff at Aiken Regional Medical Center provided brochures to all new mothers and families. Referrals were given to Aurora Pavilion if a mother expresses depression or if nurses observe symptoms of depression.
- 508 Emergency Supplies of diapers and formula provided for families in crisis.
- 206 packs of diapers were given each month for families in need.
- Car seats and instructions on installing by certified technician.
- During the evaluation at the hospital by nursing staff, MHA gets a referral of needs of any beds, car seats, clothing, formula, diapers.
- We give the invitation to new mothers to enroll their new baby into the Imagination Library. They receive books every month until child begins school.

Participants

- Every new mother at Aiken Regional Medical Center in 2020, there were 1,232.
- 206 Families of infants in need of support.
- Families in need that are referred to us for help with car seats and cribs.
- Families that receive a bed must go through Safe Sleep Education.
- Any family in Aiken County that has a child under the age of 5 years of age.

- 1,232 new mothers were provided information about newborns and post-partum depression.
- 206 families provided a week supply of diapers or formula and were referred to Life Choices for parenting classes.
- 506 one-time emergency supply of diapers or formula.
- Over 27 families were assisted through one referral for support with clothing, cribs, car seats, food or parenting support (new program added).
- So far, 108 families have received invitation however, our numbers are low because this is a new program and has been severely impacted by Covid-19.
