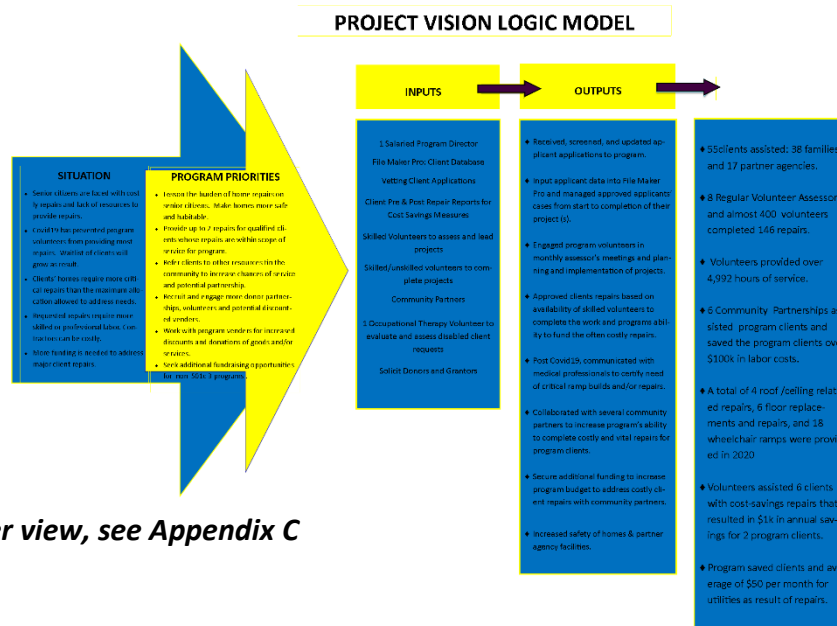

For the past three years, Project VISION volunteers have dedicated almost 27 thousand hours to repairing homes of their fellow citizens in Aiken County. Their impact has improved the quality of life for 144 families and various United Way Partner agencies.

You will notice in the chart above a gradual decline in the number of clients served from 2018 to 2019 compared to the steep decline in 2020. There are several factors that impacted this. Covid-19 limited program service and limited the types of repairs provided to clients. The greatest impact was to volunteer partnerships. All summer partnerships were cancelled. Major requests such as roofing, handicap modification to showers, flooring and other interior repairs are completed during Summer. The cancellations of those partnerships prevented 12 clients from receiving home repairs in 2020.
