Staff include HDM Coordinator, 5 Meal Site Managers, 7 part-time kitchen assistants, and 6 part-time drivers. There is no Director of Nutrition at this time.	We served 520 Senior Adults.	Clients received 1/3 RDA (Recommended Daily Allowance) meals to meet their nutritional needs and maintain independence.
ASLS has a volunteer base of over 137 members of the community to assist with this program.	We provided 75,540 hot meals in the home delivered meal program in calendar year of 2025.	Having all of our volunteers allows ASLS to provide more meals at a lower cost because ASLS can use a minimal number of paid staff for this service.
The contract that Lower Savannah Council of Governments (LSCOG) has with Senior Catering out of Orangeburg, SC provides hot and frozen meals.	The hot meals are delivered daily while the frozen meals are delivered on a weekly basis.	The addition of the frozen meals allows ASLS to serve clients who are in the rural areas where it is not possible to safely provide a hot meal daily.
Meals are distributed out of 5 facilities throughout Aiken County: Aiken, Gloverville, Jakson, Wagener, and North Augusta.	This provides easy access for our volunteers and staff easy access to the clients living throughout Aiken County.	Having 5 distribution locations for the meals ensures that the food is served at a safe temperature.
